Dear Parents and Carers,

As part of our current topic in Year 6 entitled Thrills and Spills, we will be looking at extreme sports following half term. To inspire the children and give them a first-hand experience of an extreme sport, we will be taking them to the Street Factory Skate Park in Loughborough where they will be able to have a go at Scootering and Skateboarding in a purpose built environment. This trip will take place on Wednesday 24th February with Class Cedar enjoying a one hour session from 10-11am and Class Redwood between 11 and 12pm. **To cover the costs of this learning opportunity, we are asking for a contribution of £2 per child.**

The children will need to bring in their own scooters/skateboards to school on this day, along with a helmet which must be worn at all times at the skate park. If your child does not have a scooter/skateboard/helmet, the street factory has some for them to use. **The children may wear non-school uniform on this day but they must wear trousers and a long sleeved top as the likelihood of them falling off their scooters onto their knees is high. Additionally, as we are walking down to the Skate Park, your child must be wearing sensible footwear, wearing a raincoat with a hood and, if they require a healthy snack for tuck, have their snack in their pocket.**

As this trip takes place in the morning, we will then walk the children back to school in time for their additional sessions and lunch. **The children in class Redwood will need to bring a packed lunch to school on this day as they will arrive back at school slightly late for lunch. If your child receives free school meals, their packed lunch will be provided by school.**

NB: Visiting the skate park is an incredibly exciting trip but it is classed as an extreme sport. The attached consent form must be returned with the reply slip and funds to cover all elements of health and safety concerned with this trip.
